Dancers should arrive at 9:00am. The entrance will be clearly marked. Parents drop off at entrance.

Format for Dancln'spiration 2022:

- As we have done in Arizona and now Poway for many years, we will hold the dress rehearsal and show all on the same day. This year the rehearsal and the show are on Sunday, January 16, 2022. Show time is 6:30.
- The participation fee is \$142.00 per dancer which includes two tickets to the show, dinner, masterclass (offered in the morning) and show T-shirt. Please keep in mind that proceeds go to our children's charity.
- Dancers should bring a brown bag lunch. They may sit outside the theater to eat lunch. Dinner will be provided. It is the responsibility of each studio director to ensure their dancers are properly supervised.

Participation Requirements:

Each participating dancer is required to pay a \$142 participation fee which includes two tickets to the show, masterclass, dinner and a t-shirt.

Registration will open Nov 1 and end Nov 20, 2021. Registration instructions will be sent in a separate email.

Tickets will be mailed to your studio late December/ early January.

We are requesting that each studio have a minimum of 15 participants. Each studio will be allowed to perform four numbers. We are looking for a variety of dances, so be sure to consider tap, lyrical, and musical theater numbers as well as jazz performances. Production numbers are especially appreciated! We respectfully request that your numbers feature teen and senior dancers if possible. Additionally, remember that this is a performance benefiting a

children's charity. All numbers should be appropriate for family viewing. Please avoid dark themes as well. This is meant to be an uplifting show.

Forms: Publicity materials will be sent to you, including a color flyer and a standard press release that we are encouraging you to distribute to your local/neighborhood media. Be sure to utilize social media such as Twitter, FaceBook, Instagram, etc to promote the show and our beneficiary.

Tickets: \$16, general seating. Tickets will be available 5:30-6:30pm at the door. Extra tickets ordered by Nov. 30th will be mailed to your studio.

Remember, the main purpose of a benefit show is to raise money for the charity we are supporting, and we hope that each studio will do their best to sell tickets to the show. Each studio will receive two tickets for each participating dancer. Each studio also will receive two tickets to the show at no cost.

Seating is General Admission. Kindly remember that seating will be on a first come basis and saving large blocks of seats will not be allowed. Thank you for understanding and helping us make this event work for all parties involved!

Payment: Utilize our website for payment. Cost is \$142 per dancer +\$16 for additional tickets + \$15 for additional t-shirts (staff).
